DIRECTIONS FOR USE

COOLING TOWER SYSTEMS

PRIOR TO TREATMENT WITH IPACIDE LWT 122, ALL SYSTEMS SHOULD BE CLEANED TO REMOVE ALGAL GROWTH, MICROBIOLOGICAL SLIME AND OTHER DEPOSITS.

INITIAL SLUG DOSE: ADD 420 TO 1,050 ML PER 10,000 L OF WATER IN SYSTEM. REPEAT UNTIL CONTROL IS EVIDENT.

SUBSEQUENT SLUG DOSE: ADD 120 TO 1,050 ML PER 10,000 L OF WATER EVERY 2 - 5 DAYS OR AS NEEDED. THE FREQUENCY OF ADDITION DEPENDS UPON THE AMOUNT OF BLEEDOFF AND THE SEVERITY OF THE MICROBIOLOGICAL PROBLEM. SLUG DOSE SHOULD BE ADDED TO THE SUMP OF THE WATER COOLING SYSTEMS.

INDUSTRIAL AIR WASHING SYSTEMS

PRIOR TO TREATMENT, AIR WASHERS SHOULD BE CLEANED TO REMOVE ALGAL GROWTH, MICROBIOLOGICAL SLIME AND OTHER DEPOSITS.

INITIAL SLUG DOSE: ADD 150 TO 240 ML PER 1,000 L OF SYSTEM WATER. REPEAT INITIAL DOSE UNTIL CONTROL IS EVIDENT.

SUBSEQUENT SLUG DOSE: ADD 105 TO 240 ML PER 1,000 L OF WATER EVERY 1 - 5 DAYS AS NEEDED. THE FREQUENCY OF ADDITION DEPENDS UPON THE RELATIVE AMOUNT OF BLEEDOFF AND THE SEVERITY OF MICROBIOLOGICAL PROBLEMS. SLUG DOSE SHOULD BE ADDED TO THE SUMP OR TO WATER COLLECTOR TRAYS. FOR USE ONLY IN SYSTEMS WITH EFFECTIVE MIST ELIMINATING COMPONENTS.

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DO NOT DISCHARGE EFFLUENT CONTAINING THIS PRODUCT INTO SEWER SYSTEMS, LAKES, STREAMS, PONDS, EXTRUARIES, OCEANS, AND OTHER WATERS,

PRECAUTIONS

FIRST AID

CALL A POISON CONTROL CENTRE OR DOCTOR FOR TREATMENT ADVICE. IF SWALLOWED, CALL A POISON CONTROL CENTRE OR DOCTOR IMMEDIATELY FOR TREATMENT ADVICE. HAVE PERSON SIP A GLASS OF WATER IF ABLE TO SWALLOW. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING UNLESS TOLD TO DO SO BY A POISON CONTROL CENTRE OR DOCTOR. DO NOT GIVE ANYTHING BY MOUTH TO AN UNCONSCIOUS PERSON. TAKE CONTAINER, LABEL OR PRODUCT NAME AND PEST CONTROL PRODUCT REGISTRATION NUMBER WITH YOU WHEN SEEKING MEDICAL ATTENTION.
