DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

PULP & PAPER

X-CELL 426 PAPERMILL SLIMICIDE is recommended for the control of bacterial and fungal slime in the production of paper.

POINT OF ADDITION: X-CELL 426 PAPERMILL SLIMICIDE should be added at a point in the system to ensure uniform mixing such as the Beater, Hydropulper, Fan or Broke Storage Pump.

DOSAGE: Apply 0.3 to 1.1 Kg (294 mL to 1.05 L) of X-CELL 426 PAPERMILL SLIMICIDE as supplied per tonne (dry basis) of pulp or paper produced as a slug dose. If needed repeat daily. Badly fouled systems should be cleaned before initial treatment. One litre of X-CELL 426 PAPERMILL SLIMICIDE is equivalent to 1.01 Kg.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN
