METAM CONCENTRATE is for use in manufacturing, formulating or repackaging. It is to be used only for the manufacture of industrial microbicides which are registered under the *Pest Control Products Act*.

PRECAUTIONS

PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, clothing and the contamination of food. Wear safety glasses (goggles), rubber gloves and body-protective clothing.

FIRST AID

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

If swallowed: Call a poison control center or doctor IMMEDIATELY for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. DO NOT induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Note to physician: Probable mucosal damage following ingestion may contraindicate gastric lavage. Avoid alcohol or alcohol related products. Treat symptomatically.
