DIRECTIONS FOR USE

DO NOT contaminate irrigation or drinking water supplies or aquatic habitats by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. DO NOT discharge effluent containing this product into sewer systems, lakes, streams, ponds estuaries, ocean or other waters. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

DO NOT open pour more than 20L of concentrate per day. Use an automatic addition system if using more than 20 L of concentrate per day.

Busan 1317 Liquid Microbicide is recommended for use in aqueous and water containing products and systems, including industrial, institutional and consumer pesticide products, in-can processes and products to control the growth of bacteria and fungi. For effective preservation, add Busan 1317 to the product formulation at a rate of 200 to 2000 ppm based on the water content of the product (0.2 to 2.0 g Busan 1317 Liquid Microbicide / kg of water content). Mix uniformly.

The maximum application rate for paint preservation is 100 ppm.

PRECAUTIONS

DANGER KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage. Causes skin burns. Harmful if inhaled. May be fatal if swallowed. Harmful if absorbed through skin. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals. Causes asthmatic signs and symptoms in hyper-reactive individuals. Do not get in eyes, on skin, on clothing. Avoid breathing vapors. Do not swallow. Wear coveralls over long-sleeved shirt and long pants, chemical-resistant gloves, socks, chemical-resistant footwear, and eye protection during mixing, loading, application, clean-up and repair. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Use only in well ventilated area. Remove contaminated clothing and shoes and wash them before reuse.

FIRST AID

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

If swallowed: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Do not give any liquids to the person. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Note to physician: Aspiration may cause lung damage. Probable mucosal damage following ingestion may contraindicate gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: Toxic to aquatic organisms.

DISPOSAL
