DESCRIPTION

A concentrated, multi-purpose germicidal detergent and deodorant effective in hard waters up to 400 ppm hard water (calculated as CaCO₃) plus 5% organic serum. Disinfects, cleans and deodorizes in one labor saving step. Recommended for use in mushroom farm sanitation.

BACTERICIDAL at 1:256 dilution (4ml per litre of water), shown to be effective against *Pseudomonas tolaasii*, *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*, *Staphylococcus aureus*, *Salmonella choleraesuis*, *Pseudomonas sp.* according to the AOAC. Use dilution Test Method, in the presence of 400 ppm hard water plus 5% organic serum.

FUNGICIDAL at 1:256 (4ml per litre of water), against *Verticillium fungicola*, *Mycogone perniciosa*, *Trichoderma viride*, *Dactyllum dendroides*, according to the AOAC Fungicidal Test, in the presence of 400 ppm synthetic hard water, plus 5% organic serum.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For use on hard non-porous surfaces such as floors, walls, metal surfaces, porcelain, and plastic surfaces. Remove gross filth and heavy soil deposits using a shovel, broom, or vacuum depending on area to be disinfected. Apply **VERTICIDE™** at 1:256 (4ml per litre of water) thoroughly wetting surfaces with a mop, sponge, cloth, spraying or soaking. Treated surfaces should remain wet for 10 minutes and let air dry. The recommended use solution is prepared fresh for each use, then discarded. If greater detergency is desired, dilute **VERTICIDE™** at 8 to 16 ml per litre of water.

FOR FOOT DIP OF WATERPROOF FOOTWEAR: Use **VERTICIDE™** at 1:256 (4ml per litre of water). Use foot dip according to recommended facility procedures.

PRECAUTIONS

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN, CORROSIVE. Causes eye damage and severe skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. To protect eyes, wear goggles or face shield, and to protect skin wear rubber gloves when handling. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing, wash before reuse. Harmful if swallowed. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Wear goggles or a face shield, chemical-resistant gloves, long pants, a long-sleeved shirt and shoes plus socks when handling this concentrate.

DO NOT APPLY TO MUSHROOM CROP, COMPOST OR CASING.

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ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish and other aquatic organisms. It is not to be used in circumstances that would cause or allow it to enter lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters in contravention of federal or provincial regulatory requirements. FIRST AID

If in eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If on skin or clothing, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15 - 20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If swallowed, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Avoid alcohol. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXOLOGICAL INFORMATION

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probably mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

DISPOSAL

1. Triple- or pressure-rinse the empty container. Add the rinsings to the treatment site.
2. Follow provincial instructions for any required additional cleaning of the container prior to its disposal.
3. Make the empty container unsuitable for further use.
4. Dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements.
