DISPOSAL:

STORAGE: Keep in original container during storage. Store product in a dry, no lower in temperature than 10 °C or higher than 50 °C, well-ventilated place away from seed, feed, fertilizer, or other pesticides. Keep away from fire or open flame, or other sources of heat.

FIRST-AID:

If swallowed, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measure against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed. Avoid alcohol.
