DIRECTIONS FOR USE WITH WOOD AND WOOD PRODUCTS

Supatimber(R) H.E.14 Wood Mildewcide tank mixed with ACQ (**ammoniacal copper quat**) or CCA is recommended for the protection of wood and wood products from mould and mildew degradation. Refer to the ACQ or CCA product label for specific acceptable uses.

For use with CCA solutions:

Treat with 7.5 ppm - 12 ppm active ingredient ; 41 ml - 65 ml, or 54 g - 86 g of Supatimber H.E. Wood Mildewcide per 1000 litres of CCA-C dilute solution in the pressure treating process for mold and mildew control. Under extreme mold and mildew conditions, the addition of Supatimber H.E.14 Wood Mildewcide in CCA-C dilute solution may be used up to a maximum concentration of 30 ppm active ingredient (161 ml or 214 g of Supatimber H.E. Wood Mildewcide per 1000 litres).

For use with ACQ solutions:

Treat with 5 ppm – 20 ppm active ingredient ; 26 ml - 109 ml, or 35 g to 145 g of Supatimber H.E. Wood Mildewcide per 1000 litres of ACQ dilute solution in the pressure treating process for mould and mildew control. Under extreme mold and mildew conditions, the addition of Supatimber H.E.14 Wood Mildewcide in ACQ dilute solution may be used up to a maximum concentration of 30 ppm active ingredient (161 ml or 214 g of Supatimber H.E. Wood Mildewcide per 1000 litres).

Thoroughly wet and allow to dry. A single application will afford protection for 12 weeks.

For further information on storage, handling, use, and disposal of treated wood, contact the manufacturer of this product or the provincial regulatory agency.

FIRST AID

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

Do not get in eyes, on skin, on clothing. Do not swallow. Avoid breathing vapours and spray mists. Wash skin thoroughly with soap and water after handling. ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish and other aquatic organisms. The requirements of applicable laws should be determined before using the product. Treated effluent should not be discharged where it will drain into lakes, streams, ponds or public water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of waters. Apply this product only as specified on this label. Store treated lumber on a roofed drip pad until dripping has ceased. Slope lumber on the drip pad to expedite drainage and to ensure that no puddles remain on the surface of the wood. Contain drippage and other related wastes to prevent release in the environment. DO NOT expose treated lumber to heavy rains immediately after treatment. DO NOT float treated lumber in lakes, rivers, streams, or oceans.

STORAGE PROHIBITIONS

The product as supplied evolves gas (largely carbon dioxide) slowly. To prevent buildup of pressure the product is packaged in specially vented containers. Keep this product in original container when not in use. Container must be stored and transported in an upright position to prevent spilling the contents through the vent. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. If container is plastic, do not reuse empty container.

DISPOSAL

1. Triple- or pressure-rinse the empty container. Add the rinsings to the spray mixture in the tank.
2. Follow provincial instructions for any required additional cleaning of the container prior to its disposal.

3. Make the empty container unsuitable for further use.
4. Dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements.
5. For information on the disposal of unused, unwanted product contact manufacturer or the provincial regulatory agency. Contact the manufacturer and the provincial regulatory agency in case of a spill, and for clean up of spills.

For small spills, recover free liquid. Soak up residue with solid absorbents. DO NOT FLUSH INTO SURFACE STREAMS. INFORM THE PROVINCIAL REGULATORY AGENCY OR THE MANUFACTURER.
