PRECAUTIONS

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN AND/OR PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL

Do not get in skin or in eyes. May cause discomfort to the eye, skin and respiratory tract. Use with adequate ventilation and avoid breathing dust or spray mist. If engineering control and work practices are not effective in controlling exposure to silica, protective equipment should be worn, including a NIOSH-approved respirator for amorphous silica, safety goggles, chemical resistant gloves, and protective clothing.

FIRST AID

If in eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If on skin or clothing, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If swallowed, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If inhaled, Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.
