**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** To be used in the manufacture of an insecticide which is registered under the PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS ACT.

**PRECAUTIONS: PREVENT ACCES BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL.** Avoid contact with eyes. Use adequate ventilation and avoid breathing dust. Causes irritation and soreness in throat and nose in cases of extreme exposure. Some congestion may occur. Wear eye protection and NIOSH-approved respiratory protection (e.g. N95 respirator certified to standard 42CFR84) when handling the product. NIOSH recommendations for diatomaceous earth vary depending on the anticipated air concentration and NIOSH documentation should be consulted.

**FIRST AID:**

If swallowed, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on skin or clothing, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If inhaled, move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

If in eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes.

Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

**TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:** Treat symptomatically.

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool dry place.
